Background - BAL MILAN PROGRAM

BAL MILAN is a gathering of rural children to encourage students to participate in sports and cultural activities for a healthy and active lifestyle. Through this BAL Milan, we are taking a step towards promoting the poor and vulnerable children for good quality education and making them independent citizens of our country. SRC has organized BAL MILAN (Sports and Cultural activities) for school-going children of Waghodia block.

The Corona epidemic has devastated human life. Business, employment, and school colleges were closed for a long time. After a two-year epidemic, public life has slowly begun to throb. At a time when educational institutions are reopening after a long hiatus, Parul University has organized a BAL MILAN program to preserve Sports and Cultural heritage among School children in the rural area.

The Program was planned under the leadership of Dr. Geetika Patel, Chairperson of SRC.

Sports Program

1. 100 meter running race
2. 200 meter running race
3. Lemon spoon
4. Balloon game
5. Musical Chair

Cultural Program

1. Group Dance
2. Solo Dance
3. Solo Singing

First of all, SRC Team met the Taluka Primary Education Officer of Waghodia for permission for the program. After getting approval from Taluka Primary Education Officer, team personally met the principals of schools of Waghodia block and invited them for the program; they encouraged children to participate in the program. SRC had meeting with various SRC coordinators of Parul University and discussed the implementation of the program and prepared a successful plan for the BAL Milan program, in which roles and responsibilities were allocated to them. Invitation letters and emails were sent to respected dignitaries according to the list of invitees and donors etc. Food and medals for the winners of the program was sponsored by the NSS. Central Bank of India also gave the donation of the amount of Rs.4000.

This time Bal Milan Program was organized for 4 days. That is on 22nd December 2023, 4th, 5th and 12th January 2024. We invited 28 schools for this program and 25 schools were happily participated in this program.

Process Report

On 22nd December 2023, the Program was started at 10:00 am at the hockey ground with a warm welcome by SRC Team. Respected Geetika Patel, Chairperson of the SRC & Member of the governing body, and Medical Director, Parul University had grace the occasion as a chief guest of the program. Also Mr. Magan Parmar, Dean of Faculty of Social Work and Mr. Vinod Parmar, SRC Coordinator, PU had graced the Occasion. Mr. Vinod, SRC coordinator welcomed all the dignitaries then the program was inaugurated by blowing Bal Milan's banner in the air with balloons. After that respected Geetika ma'am motivated children & staff by giving her valuable speech. The Sports activities started with the 100-meter running race for girls and boys, then 200-meter race, lemon spoon, balloon game and at last played musical chair with children. All staff members also played balloon game. The sports departments of PU have taken responsibility for playing all the sports activities. The winners from all the games were selected by the sports department and list of winners was prepared by the SRC team.

After the Lunch, The Program started at 2:00 pm with a warm Welcome by Mr. Vinod Parmar. All the participants & teachers, and the organizer were present for cultural activities in the

medical College building. The chief guest for the cultural activities was the Mr.Amit Ganatra Sir, Provost of Parul University. He gave his valuable speech to all the students and motivated them for the competition.

The cultural activities started with the welcome dance by the students of Faculty of Physiotherapy. The cultural activities started with the Group Dance presented by all the present schools of the Waghodiya block. All the performance of the group dance was amazing. All the children & teachers put good efforts into it. After the group performance, there was solo singing competition, and at last, the solo dancing was performed by all the participants.

It was difficult to judge the performances because all the performances were amazing mind-blowing, however, the judges decided on the winner by their distinctive insights.

At the End of the cultural activities, the felicitation of coordinators of SRC from various faculties was done and 3 ranks were given to the best 3 coordinators of the year for their work done by them throughout the year. Mr. Vinod Parmar praised them with momento and certificates. Mr. Vinod Parmar motivated other coordinators by giving them certificates and also praised their work through words.

After that Mr. Vinod Parmar invited the dignitaries for the valedictory session on the dais. The sports activities winners were given a medal with a certificate by the signatories. After then all the winners of the cultural activities were given trophies and certificates. School participant certificates were given to all 7 schools for motivation purposes. At End of the program, the national anthem was sung and the program was concluded with vote of thanks by Mr. Vinod Parmar. The stationery kit of DOMS was given as a consolidated prize to all the participated children.

The other 3 Bal Milan programs were same as the first Bal Milan program. The process and all the activities same as the first Bal Milan program. Only chief guest were changed during the other program. Mr.Jagdish Gohil, Dean Parul Institute of Medical Science and Research was the chief guest of cultural event on 4th January. Mrs. Komal Patel, Vice President PU was the chief guest of cultural event on 5th January. Both the chief guest gave their valuable speech to the children and motivated them about true sportsmanship. Mr. Vinod Parmar felicitated the coordinators who actively participated throughout the event with the token of appreciation. The
