### Activity Details:

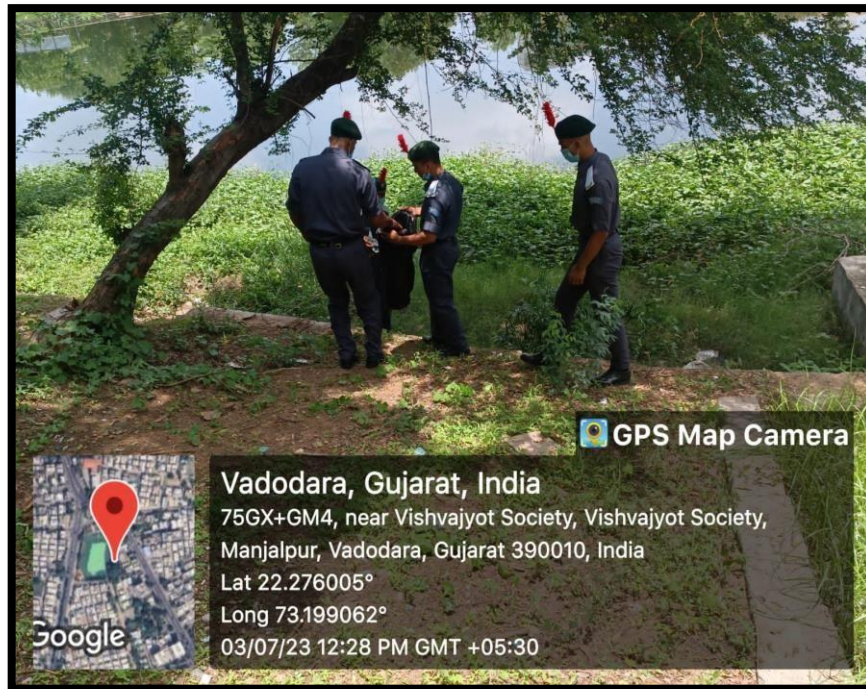

Awareness of environmental hazards such as air and water pollution enables individuals to take measures to protect their health and well-being.

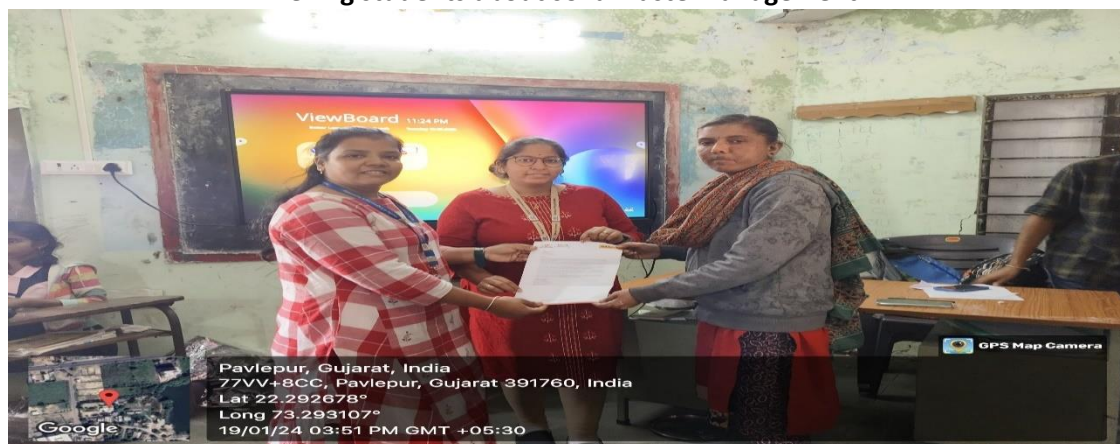
### Interactive Q&A Session:

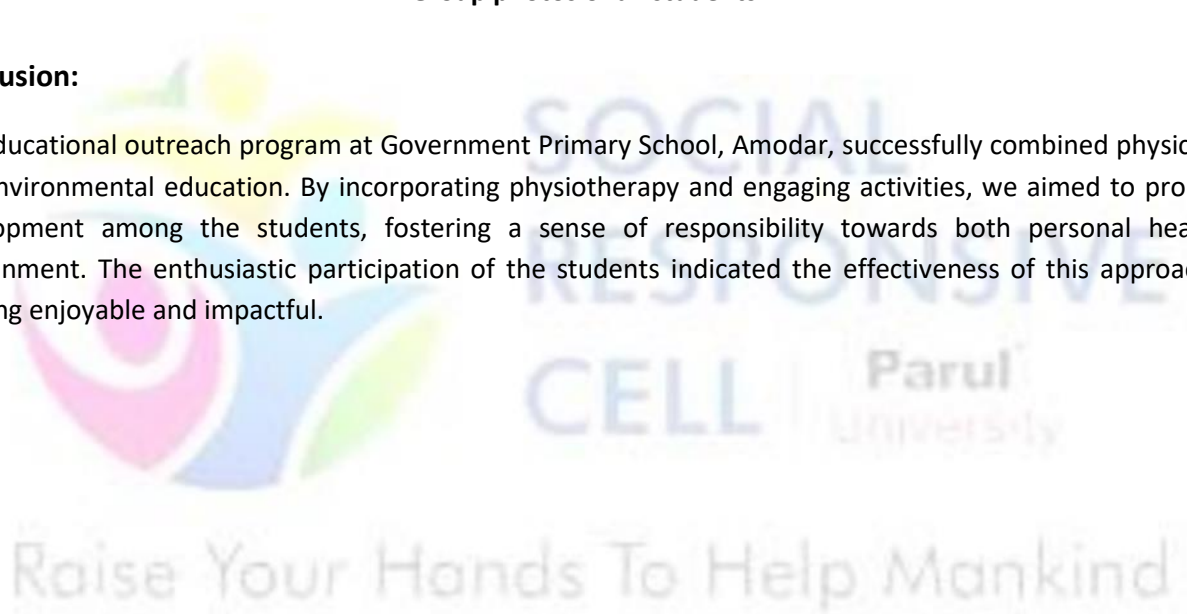

- Distribution of Informational Resources:** To provide the community members with informational materials and resources that serve as references for understanding the electoral process and making informed decisions during the elections.

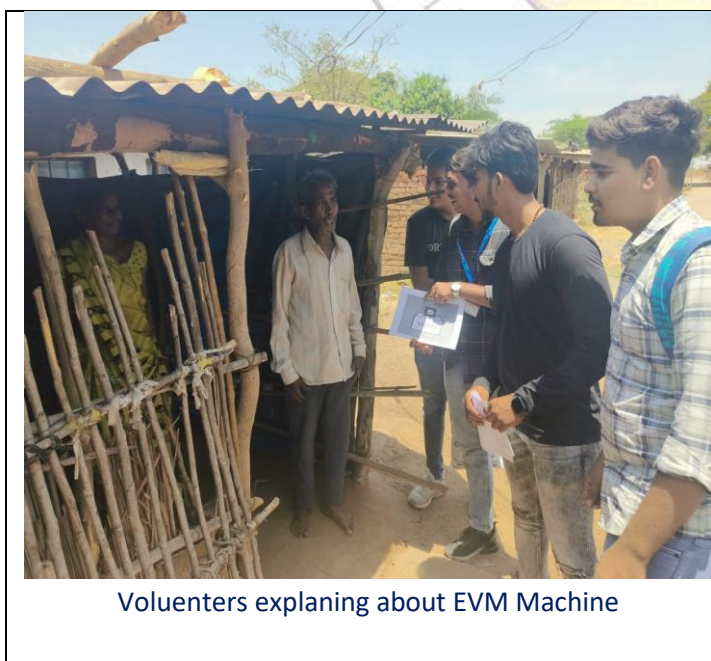
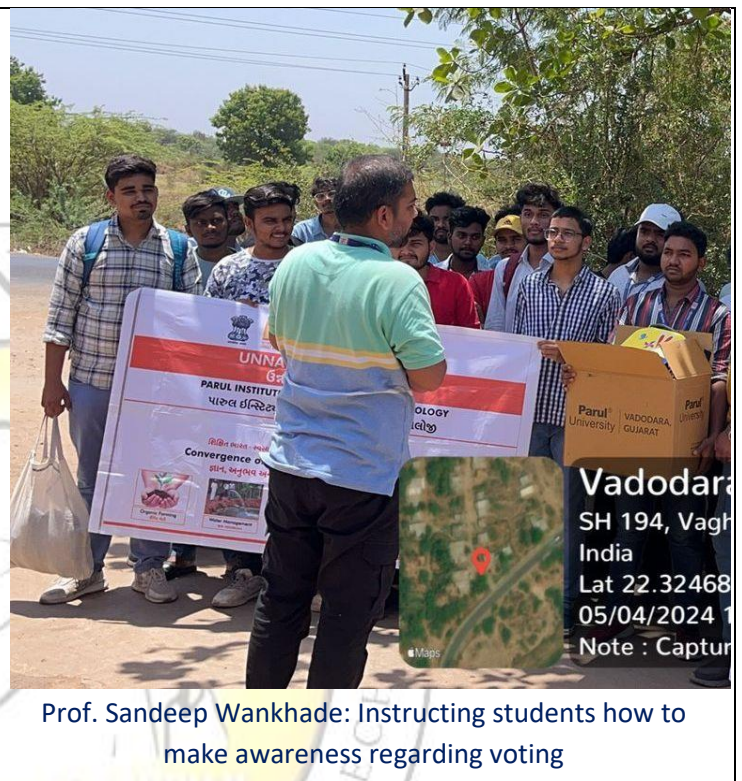
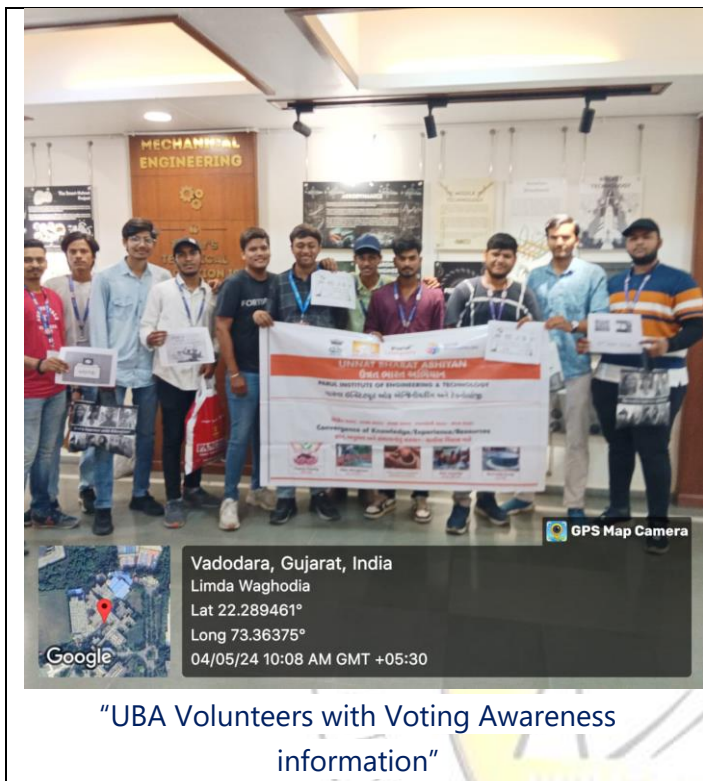

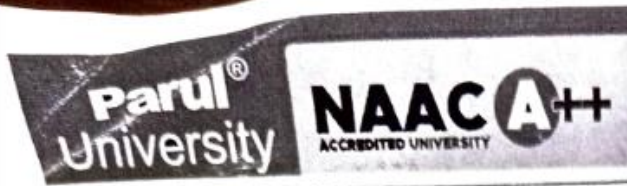
#### Activity Details:

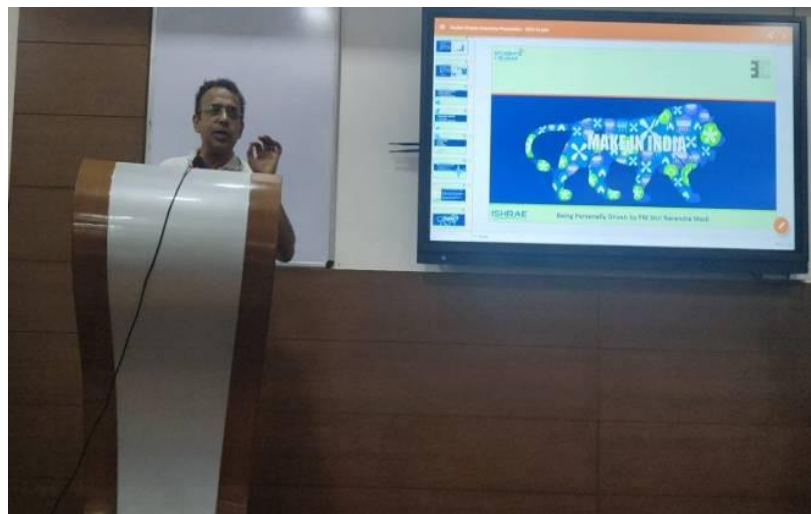
